

## Bioresonance Therapy

Margaret Bartlett uncovers an energetic way of eliminating allergies

### WHAT IS IT?

Bioresonance therapy aims to diagnose the causes of allergic reactions, and then eliminate the allergy through the use of electromagnetic oscillations.

Allergic reactions occur when the immune system assumes a substance entering the body is harmful, causing antibodies to be produced. This therapy aims to reprogramme the cells to accept the substance and not react to it.

Practitioner Anne Bacon says she first measures, or reads the, vibrational properties of small samples of 1,000 common allergens, such as wheat, dairy

substance." A mirror image of the resonance, or oscillations, is then sent back to the client at low frequency.

"The body recognises substances by their frequencies; it may think that frequency is a virus and go into the attack mode.

For some reason, it has an incorrect programme for that substance, which is embedded in every cell. By sending the mirror image of that frequency back to the body, it will break apart the pattern it holds for that substance. The body then has to reprogramme itself and put it right," she explains. There may be an underlying reason why the body holds an

invasive." Elimination of allergic reactions can happen very quickly claims Bacon. "I had a wheat allergy and it was fixed within 3 weeks."

At the end of the session, the resonances are tested again to see if the allergic reaction has been eliminated. "It takes two or three days for the body to work through it and reprogramme itself." Bacon says a client needs to abstain from consuming the offending substance for at least two or three weeks while undergoing treatment. "You can't get rid of a problem if the patient is still eating the allergen." Clients don't feel anything during a session but are often tired afterwards, as the body detoxifies.

Actress Emma Jones, 31, has suffered from eczema for years and was disillusioned with hospital diagnosis using patch tests, and the resulting steroid treatment. She heard about Energy Medicine through a friend, who said Bioresonance therapy had cured her of a wheat allergy.

Bacon found that Emma had a form of Candida overgrowth which explains why her eczema was coming and going. 'I didn't feel anything during the treatment or afterwards. It's been six weeks since my first treatment and I have already noticed an improvement,' says Emma. 'I have one more treatment to go and I am feeling very positive about it.'

products, pollen and chemicals. The client then sits seven to eight inches away from the machine, holding an electrode in each hand, while the practitioner plays back the vibrations of each allergen.

"If I then get a resonance with the client, it means they have an allergy to that

incorrect programme, says Bacon, such as an overgrowth of the bacteria Candida or an internal parasite. This cause can also be treated by inverting the bacteria's own frequency.

Bacon says the client can even go to sleep during a treatment, as no touch is required. "It's totally non-

### HISTORY

In 1987, The Brugemann Institute in Germany was the first to use the term Bioresonance Therapy. However, German doctor Franz Morell, a successful electro-acupuncturist, first presented this technique in 1977. Morell built an electronic device able to receive and return oscillations to patients.

Since then, the therapy has been used and refined by over 4,000 practitioners world-wide. It is used extensively in the US. In Germany, many doctors, vets and dentists use it alongside orthodox medicine. The therapy has recently been brought to the UK and is used by a small group of practitioners.

## **EVIDENCE**

Its effectiveness is mostly supported by successful case histories, although there have been clinical studies done at the Oncology Institute of the Academy of Science in the Ukraine and at the University of Salford in the UK.

One clinical study by Dr Schumacher, involving 200 people, showed that 83% of those who received the therapy no longer displayed a reaction to the allergen. An additional 11% were greatly improved. In a follow up survey 4 to 10 months later, the lasting effects of the treatment were confirmed.

## **WHEN SHOULD YOU USE IT?**

As allergies can manifest in many ways, anyone with unexplained and persistent symptoms may benefit from the therapy. Symptoms such as asthma, bloating, depression, irritable bowel syndrome, persistent cough, dermatitis, eczema, hayfever, hives, joint pain, fatigue, migraine and weight gain may be caused by allergies.

## **CAN ANYONE BE TREATED?**

As the treatment activates the immune system, it is not advisable for anyone with autoimmune disease, rheumatoid arthritis or those with multiple sclerosis. Women in the first three months of pregnancy or anyone fitted with a pacemaker are advised not to undergo the therapy. It is suitable for children of all ages.
